Faith Doesn't Stand Around With Its Hand In Its Pockets! Game Plan 2016: Everything We Need For Life And Godliness!

Pt.2 2 Peter 1:5-9 January 17, 2016

God's Part: His Power And Promises - 2 Peter 1:1-4

<u>2 Peter 1:1</u>, Simon Peter, a servant and apostle of Jesus Christ, To those who through the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus Christ have received <u>a faith as **precious**</u> as ours: ²Grace and peace be yours in abundance through the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord. ³His divine power has given us everything we need for a godly life through our knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and <u>goodness</u>. ⁴Through these He has given us His very great and <u>precious</u> promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature, having escaped the corruption in the world caused by evil desires.

God Has Given Us A Priceless Faith; Grace And Peace Multiplied; Everything We Need For Life And Godliness; And Priceless Promises.

Our Part: Faith And Diligence - 2 Peter 1:5-9

<u>2 Peter 1:5,</u> For this very reason, <u>make every effort to add to</u> your <u>faith goodness</u>; and to goodness, <u>knowledge</u>; ⁶and to knowledge, <u>self-control</u>; and to self-control, <u>perseverance</u>; and to perseverance, <u>godliness</u>; ⁷and to godliness, <u>mutual affection</u>; and to mutual affection, <u>love</u>. ⁸For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being <u>ineffective</u> and <u>unproductive</u> in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁹But whoever does not have them is nearsighted and blind, forgetting that they have been cleansed from their past sins.

• It All Starts With Faith, But It Doesn't STOP THERE!

Romans 10:9, If you <u>declare</u> with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and <u>believe</u> in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰For it is with your heart that you <u>believe</u> and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you <u>profess</u> your <u>faith</u> and are saved. ¹¹As Scripture says, "Anyone who <u>believes</u> in Him will never be put to shame..." ¹³for, "<u>Everyone</u> who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

<u>Galatians 2:16</u>, We... know that a person is not justified by the works of the law, <u>but by faith in Jesus Christ</u>. So we, too, have put our <u>faith</u> in Christ Jesus that we may be justified by <u>faith</u> in Christ and not by the works of the law, because by the works of the law no one will be justified.

Ephesians 2:8, For it is by grace you have been saved, through <u>faith</u>—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—⁹ not by works, so that no one can boast. ¹⁰For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus <u>to do good works</u>, which God prepared in advance for us <u>to do</u>.

Thought: Grace eliminates any idea of effort being involved in our salvation, but it encourages great effort because of our salvation!

Faith Doesn't Stand Around With Its Hands In Its <u>POCKETS</u>

<u>2 Peter 1:5</u>, For this very reason, <u>make every effort to add to</u> your <u>faith</u>...

Romans 12:6, We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then <u>prophesy</u> in accordance with your faith; ⁷if it is serving, <u>then serve</u>; if it is teaching, <u>then teach</u>; ⁸if it is to encourage, <u>then give</u>

<u>encouragement</u>; if it is giving, <u>then give generously</u>; if it is to lead, <u>do it diligently</u>; if it is to show mercy, <u>do it cheerfully</u>. ⁹Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; <u>cling to what is good</u>. ¹⁰<u>Be</u> <u>devoted to one another</u> in love. <u>Honor one another</u> above yourselves. ¹¹<u>Never be lacking in zeal</u>, <u>but keep your spiritual</u> <u>fervor</u>, <u>serving the Lord</u>. ¹²<u>Be joyful</u> in hope, <u>patient</u> in affliction, <u>faithful</u> in prayer. ¹³<u>Share</u> with the Lord's people who are in need. <u>Practice</u> hospitality.

• The First Virtue Of Genuine Faith Is <u>MORAL</u> <u>GOODNESS</u>

<u>2 Peter 1:5</u>, For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith **<u>goodness</u>**...

<u>Micah 6:8</u>, *He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you?* <u>*To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.*</u>

Colossians 3:1, Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.²Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things...⁵Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry...⁷You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived. ⁸But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. ⁹Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices ¹⁰ and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its *Creator*...¹²*Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly* loved, clothe vourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. ¹³Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave vou.¹⁴And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

<u>Closing Thought</u>: Genuine faith is a right belief that results in **RIGHT BEHAVIOR**!
