Dominican Republic Mission Trip

18 members from Cottonwood & 2 leaders from NEXT Worldwide traveled to Puerto Plato to serve alongside our good friends at Mashach Ministries. Though there was much opposition, it brought great opportunity and we were able to see the incredible power of God through it all. Our team shared the gospel with over 400 people and 80 made decisions to accept Christ as their Lord and Savior!! Praise God for bringing more people to Himself! Along with going out and sharing the good news, we also were able to hand out 350+ meals and gave out over 500 pairs of glasses with our eye clinic. It was such a blessing to get to join God in His mission to meet both the spiritual and the physical need. We left knowing that the leaders and members of the church are going to continue to minister to the area and follow up with those who made faith decisions or expressed interest in learning more.



Baltimore Mission Trip

"Our 21 member team divided up to work with 3 different church plants in the Baltimore area. Because of the rain, our plans had to be adjusted, but all went well and we were able to accomplish a lot! I worked mostly with Graffiti Church doing demo of a 3 story building they acquired. Our team of 6 along with another team from North Carolina were able to knock out walls and ceilings to get ready for the renovations. Another group worked with Church of the Harbor cleaning, painting and laying carpet in a church building they acquired by merging with FBC, Essex. The 3rd group worked with Captivate Church with VBS. We also canvased in the neighborhood of Church of the Harbor to invite the community to a Block Party. On Friday afternoon, our team worked the Bus Stop Outreach for Graffiti Church passing out hot dogs, picking up trash, and passing out flyers inviting them to church. It was an honor and blessing to serve these churches and serve with this team in order to accomplish great things for the Kingdom of God!
