## A Legit Faith Learns To Live In The Moment! Legit Faith: All Day, Everyday! Pt. 6

James 4:13-17 May 8, 2016

James 4:13, Now listen, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money." <sup>14</sup>Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. <sup>15</sup>Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." <sup>16</sup>As it is, you boast in your arrogant schemes. All such boasting is evil. <sup>17</sup>If anyone, then, knows the good they ought to do and doesn't do it, it is sin for them.

## **Three Thoughts On Living In The Moment From James:**

# 1) Don't Live In A State Of Personal MYOPIA

<u>James 4:13</u>, Now listen, you who say, "<u>Today or tomorrow</u> we will go to this or that city, <u>spend a year there</u>, <u>carry on business and make money</u>."

- Myopic Living Focuses On Today Or Tomorrow
- Myopic Living Depends On Our Own Abilities
- Myopic Living Spends Life Pursuing <u>EARTHLY</u> PROFIT

Luke 12:15, Then He said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; life does not consist in an abundance of possessions." <sup>16</sup>And He told them this parable: "The ground of a certain rich man yielded an abundant harvest. <sup>17</sup>He thought to himself, 'What shall I do? I have no place to store my crops.' <sup>18</sup> "Then he said, 'This is what I'll do. I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones, and there I will store my surplus grain. <sup>19</sup>And I'll say to myself, "You have plenty of grain laid up for many years. Take life

easy; eat, drink and be merry." But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?' This is how it will be with whoever stores up things for themselves but is not rich toward God."

## 2) Don't Live A MISDIRECTED LIFE

<u>James 4:14,</u> Why, <u>you do not even know what will happen</u> <u>tomorrow</u>. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes... <sup>16</sup>As it is, <u>you boast in your arrogant schemes</u>. All such boasting is evil.

# Misdirected Lives Are Filled With Pride And Arrogance

<u>1 John 2:16</u>, For everything in the world—the cravings of sinful man, the lust of his eyes and the boasting of what he has and does—comes not from the Father but from the world. <sup>17</sup>The world and its desires pass away, but the man who does the will of God lives forever. (Proverbs 27:1)

## 3) Do Live Faithfully In The MOMENT

<u>James 4:15, Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that."</u> ... <sup>17</sup>If anyone, then, knows the good they ought to do and doesn't do it, it is sin for them.

- Prayerful Consideration Before <u>MAJOR DECISIONS</u>
- JUST DO IT!

<u>Psalm 37:3</u>, Trust in the LORD <u>and do good</u>; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture. <sup>4</sup>Delight yourself in the LORD

and <u>He will give you the desires of your heart</u>. <sup>5</sup>Commit your way to the LORD; trust in Him and <u>He will do it</u>."
