# A Face Of Grace Reaches Out To Those Who Are Untouchable! Faces Of Grace, Pt. 5

Matthew 8:1-4 July 3, 2016

Matthew 8:1, When Jesus came down from the mountainside, large crowds followed Him. <sup>2</sup>A man with leprosy came and knelt before Him and said, "Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean." <sup>3</sup>Jesus reached out His hand and touched the man. "I am willing," He said. "Be clean!" Immediately he was cleansed of his leprosy. <sup>4</sup>Then Jesus said to him, "See that you don't tell anyone. But go, show yourself to the priest and offer the gift Moses commanded, as a testimony to them."

### **Two Overarching Principles From This Passage:**

- 1. The universal need for love and grace by all humanity
- 2. Jesus' example of reaching out to those deemed untouchable by others

## Four Thoughts From Jesus' Encounter With The Leper:

- 1. Jesus' Attraction And His Circle Of <u>INFLUENCE</u>

  <u>Matthew 8:1</u>, When Jesus came down from the mountainside, large crowds followed Him.
- 2. Jesus Acknowledges An Approaching <u>UNTOUCHABLE</u>

  <u>Matthew 8:2</u>, A man with <u>leprosy came and knelt before</u>

  Him and said, "Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean."
  - <u>Leviticus 13:45</u>, "Anyone with such a defiling disease must wear torn clothes, let their hair be unkempt, cover the lower part of their face and cry out, '<u>Unclean!</u>' <u>Unclean!</u>' 46As long as

they have the disease they remain unclean. <u>They must live</u> alone; they must live outside the camp."

#### 3. Jesus ENGAGES The Untouchable

<u>Matthew 8:3</u>, Jesus reached out His hand and touched the <u>man</u>. "I am willing," He said. "Be clean!" Immediately he was cleansed of his leprosy.

<u>Matthew 5:46</u>, If you love those who love you, what reward will you get? Are not even the tax collectors doing that? <sup>47</sup>And if you greet only your own people, what are you doing more than others? Do not even pagans do that?

## 4. Jesus **INSTRUCTS** The Untouchable

<u>Matthew 8:4</u>, Then Jesus said to him, "See that you don't tell anyone. <u>But go</u>, <u>show yourself to the priest and offer the gift Moses commanded</u>, as a testimony to them."

Luke 19:10, For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.

<u>Proverbs 11:30</u>, The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and the one who is wise saves lives.

Matthew 28:18, Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. <sup>19</sup>Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup>and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."
