Hebrews 13:15, Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that openly profess His name. ¹⁶And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased. ¹⁷Have confidence in your leaders and submit to their authority, because they keep watch over you as those who must give an account. 2. A Life Of Sacrifice SERVES OTHERS!

<u>**Hebrews 13:16,**</u> And do not forget to do good...

Galatians 6:9, Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. ¹⁰Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.

3. A Life Of Sacrifice Gives Generously For The Sake Of OTHERS!

<u>Hebrews 13:16</u>, And do not forget to do good and to share with others...

<u>Matthew 6:19</u>, "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves

break in and steal. ²⁰But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. ²¹For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

Jesus Said, Generosity Benefits My Life...

• Generosity Breaks The Grip Of <u>MATERIALISM!</u>
<u>Matthew 6:19</u>, "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal."

<u>Matthew 6:24</u>, "... You cannot serve both God and money."

• Generosity Is An Investment For ETERNITY!

Matthew 6:20, But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal.

<u>1 Timothy 6:18</u>, Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share. ¹⁹In this way they will lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that they may take hold of the life that is truly life.

• Generosity Draws Me <u>CLOSER</u> To God! <u>Matthew 6:21</u>, For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

<u>John 3:16</u>, For God so loved the world that He <u>gave</u> His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.

Generosity Opens Me Up For God To <u>BLESS ME</u>!

<u>Deuteronomy 15:10</u>, Give generously to them and do so without a grudging heart; then because of this the Lord your God will bless you in all your work and in everything you put your hand to.

<u>Proverbs 22:9</u>, The generous will themselves be blessed...
