Deuteronomy 4:9, Only be careful, and watch yourselves closely so that you <u>do not forget</u> the things your eyes have seen or let them fade from your heart as long as you live. Teach them to your children and to their children after them. ¹⁰<u>Remember</u> the day you stood before the Lord...

Five Things We Have Learned And Always Want To Remember:

1. All Things Are <u>POSSIBLE</u> With God!

Psalm 78:7, "In this way each generation has been able to...set its hope anew on God and <u>not forget His glorious miracles.</u>"

2. We Cannot <u>OUT GIVE</u> God!

<u>2</u> Corinthians 9:6, <u>Remember this</u>: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. ⁷Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. ⁸And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.</u>

3. Genuine Faith Requires <u>ACTION</u>!

James 2:17, In the same way, faith by itself, <u>if it is not</u> <u>accompanied by action, is dead</u>. ¹⁸But someone will say, "You have faith; I have deeds." Show me your faith without deeds, and <u>I will</u> <u>show you my faith by my deeds</u>.

4. We Grow Most When We SACRIFICE For Others!

<u>**2** Chronicles 16</u>, "The eyes of the Lord range through the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to Him."

Hebrews 13:15-17, Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that openly profess His name. ¹⁶And <u>do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased</u>.
