#### Home Run Living Theme Verse:

**<u>1 Peter 2:9</u>**, But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for His own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.

## Hitting The Cycle Requires 3 Things:

## 1) Humility Towards Christ The CHIEF SHEPHERD

**<u>1 Peter 5:1</u>**, To the <u>elders among you</u>, I appeal as a <u>fellow elder</u> and a witness of Christ's sufferings who also will share in the glory to be revealed: <u><sup>2</sup>Be shepherds</u> of God's flock that <u>is under</u> your care, <u>watching over them</u>—not because you must, but <u>because you are willing</u>, as God wants you to be; <u>not pursuing</u> <u>dishonest gain</u>, <u>but eager to serve</u>; <u><sup>3</sup>not lording it over those</u> <u>entrusted to you</u>, but <u>being examples to the flock</u>. <sup>4</sup>And when the <u>Chief Shepherd</u> appears, you will receive the crown of glory that will never fade away.

### What Does The New Testament Say About Elders/Overseers?

They are...

LOCAL - Not Distant "Among You" <u>Titus 1:5</u>, The reason I left you in Crete was that you might put in order what was left unfinished and appoint elders in every town, as I directed you.

• <u>MULTIPLE</u> - Not Singular "E

"Elders/Overseers"

(Elders or Bishops-Plural: Acts 11:30; 15:2; 16:4; 20:17; 21:18; 1 Timothy 5:17; Titus 1:5; Hebrews 13:7, 24; James 5:14; 1 Peter 5:1)

## • HIGH CHARACTER Individuals

"Examples To The Flock" <u>**1 Timothy 3:1**</u>, *Here is a trustworthy saying: Whoever aspires to be an <u>overseer</u> desires a <u>noble task</u>. <sup>2</sup>Now the overseer is to be <u>above reproach</u>, <u>faithful to his wife</u>, <u>temperate</u>, <u>self-controlled</u>, <u>respectable</u>, <u>hospitable</u>, <u>able to</u> <u>teach</u>, <sup>3</sup>not given to drunkenness, <u>not violent but gentle</u>, <u>not quarrelsome</u>, <u>not a lover of money</u>.* 

## <u>SHEPHERDS</u> Of God's People

"Be Shepherds of God's Flock" (1 Peter 5:1-4: Elders Care For, Watch Over, Financially Trustworthy, Serve Eagerly, Don't Dictate) (1 Timothy 1:1-7: Elders/Overseers Are Kind, Able To Teach, Spiritually Mature, Good Managers Of Their Household, Not Arrogant, Good Reputation With Outsiders)

**<u>Simple Statement</u>**: Elders/Overseers are spiritually mature men of good reputation who are actively leading, teaching, and caring for God's people in a local setting.

# 2) Humility Towards Those More <u>SPIRITUALLY MATURE</u>

<u>**1 Peter 5:5**</u>, In the same way, you who are younger, <u>submit</u> yourselves to your elders. <u>All of you, clothe yourselves with</u> <u>**humility** toward one another</u>, because, "God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble."

3) Humility Towards God's <u>PLAN FOR YOUR LIFE</u>

<u>1 Peter 5:6, Humble yourselves</u>, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that He may lift you up in due time. <u>7Cast all your anxiety</u> <u>on Him because He cares for you</u>. <sup>8</sup>Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. <sup>9</sup>Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that the family of believers throughout the world is undergoing the same kind of sufferings. <sup>10</sup>And the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will Himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast.
