2 Peter 1:5-9 February 14, 2016

**2 Peter 1:5,** For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; <sup>6</sup> and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; <sup>7</sup> and to godliness, mutual affection; and to mutual affection, <u>love</u>. <sup>8</sup> For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>9</sup> But whoever does not have them is nearsighted and blind, forgetting that they have been cleansed from their past sins.

### The Bible Says:

Agape Love is used 115 times in the New Testament. Agape may involve emotions, but it always involves action. Agape is unrestricted, unconditional, sacrificial love.

## • God Is Agape Love

<u>1 John 4:8</u>, Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is <u>love</u>. <sup>9</sup>This is how God showed His <u>love</u> among us: He sent His one and only Son into the world that we might live through Him.

# • Agape Love Is Active Love

<u>John 3:16</u>, For God so <u>loved</u> the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.

# Agape Love Is Our Best Witness

<u>John 13:34</u>, "A new command I give you: <u>Love</u> one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. <sup>35</sup>By this everyone will know that you are My disciples, if you <u>love</u> one another."

## Agape Love Is Multifaceted

<u>1 Corinthians 13:4, Love</u> is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. <sup>5</sup>It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. <sup>6</sup>Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. <sup>7</sup>It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. <sup>8</sup>Love never fails... <sup>13</sup>And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.

### "For Better Or For Worse!"

<u>Ephesians 5:33</u>, *However, each one of you also must <u>love</u> his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must <u>respect</u> her husband.*

### 1) Hard Work And Total COMMITMENT

Mark 10:6, "But at the beginning of creation God 'made them male and female.' For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh.' So they are no longer two, but one. Therefore what God has joined together, let man not separate."

<u>1 Corinthians 7:28</u>, But if you do marry, you have not sinned... <u>But those who marry will face many troubles</u> in this life, and I want to spare you this.

# 3) Clear And Caring COMMUNICATION

<u>Colossians 4:6</u>, Let your conversation <u>be always full of grace</u>...

<u>Colossians 3:19</u>, *Husbands, love your wives and <u>do not be</u> harsh with them.* 

<u>Proverbs 21:9</u>, It is better to live in a corner of a roof than in a house shared with a <u>contentious woman</u>.

# 4) Keep A Good Sense Of HUMOR

<u>Proverbs 17:22</u>, A cheerful heart is good medicine... <u>Proverbs 15:15</u>, ...the cheerful heart has a <u>continual feast</u>.
