Love Reigns In Our Relationships When We Understand:

1. Love's <u>PREEMINENCE</u>

<u>1 Corinthians 13:1</u>, If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. ²If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing.³If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing.

- Love's Preeminence In <u>SPEECH</u> <u>1 Corinthians 13:1</u>, If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a <u>resounding gong</u> or a <u>clanging cymbal</u>.
- Love's Preeminence In <u>ATTITUDE</u> <u>1 Corinthians 13:2</u>, If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, <u>I am</u> <u>nothing</u>.
- Love's Preeminence In <u>ACTION</u>

<u>**1** Corinthians 13:3</u>, If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing.

2. Love's <u>PROPERTIES</u>

<u>1 Corinthians 13:4</u>, Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. ⁵It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. ⁶Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. ⁷It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.

- Love's Properties Concerning <u>OTHERS</u> <u>1 Corinthians 13:4</u>, *Love is patient*, *love is kind*. It does not envy...
- Love's Properties Concerning <u>ITSELF</u>
 <u>1 Corinthians 13:4</u>, ...<u>it does not boast</u>, <u>it is not</u>
 <u>proud</u>. ⁵It does not dishonor others, <u>it is not self-seeking</u>...
- Love's Properties Concerning <u>CIRCUMSTANCES</u> <u>1 Corinthians 13:5</u>, *it is not easily angered, it keeps no* <u>record of wrongs</u>. ⁶Love does not delight in evil but <u>rejoices with the truth</u>.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:19</u>, that God was reconciling the world to Himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And He has committed to us the message of reconciliation.

Proverbs 17:9, Whoever would foster love covers over an offense, but whoever repeats the matter separates close friends.

• Summary of Love's <u>PROPERTIES</u> <u>1 Corinthians 13:7</u>, It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.

Ephesians 4:29, Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen... ³¹Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. ³²Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

3. Love's <u>PERMANENCE</u>

<u>**1** Corinthians 13:8</u>, Love never fails... ¹³And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.

John 13:34, "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. ³⁵By this everyone will know that you are My disciples, if you love one another."
