Psalm 1 January 8, 2017

<u>2 Corinthians 13:5</u>, Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you—unless, of course, you fail the test?

Romans 6:23, For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

<u>Jeremiah 29:13</u>, You will seek Me and <u>find Me when you seek</u> Me with all your heart.

Five Keys To Spiritually Healthy People:

1. Spiritual Health Begins With The <u>COMPANY YOU KEEP</u>

<u>Psalm 1:1</u>, Blessed is the one who does not <u>walk</u> in step with the wicked or <u>stand</u> in the way that sinners take or <u>sit</u> in the company of mockers...

<u>Matthew 5:6</u>, Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.

<u>Proverbs 11:27</u>, Whoever seeks good finds favor, but evil comes to one who searches for it.

2. Spiritually Healthy People Soak Up GOD'S WORD

Psalm 1:2, but whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and who meditates on His law day and night.

<u>Psalm 37:4</u>, Take delight in the Lord, and He will give you the desires of your heart.

<u>Proverbs 16:20</u>, He who gives attention to the Word will find good, And blessed is he who trusts in the LORD.

3. Spiritually Healthy People PRODUCE FRUIT

<u>Psalm 1:3</u>, That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which <u>yields its fruit in season</u> and whose leaf does not wither—<u>whatever they do prospers</u>.

John 15:4, Remain in Me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in Me.

4. Spiritually Healthy People WEATHER THE STORMS

<u>Psalm 1:3</u>, That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither—whatever they do prospers. ⁴Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away.

<u>Jeremiah 17:7</u>, "But blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord, whose confidence is in Him. ⁸They will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit."

5. Spiritually Healthy People Live With **INTEGRITY**

<u>Psalm 1:5</u>, Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous. ⁶For the Lord watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked leads to destruction.

<u>Isaiah 1:18</u>, "... Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool."

- Read Psalm 1 and memorize it. Whenever you find yourself weighed down by the world, meditate on the truth of this psalm, letting it encourage you spiritually, relationally and emotionally.
