The Lost Son And The Loving Father

Luke 15:11-24

1. I Must Get FED UP With My LIFE

Luke 15:13, Not long after that, the younger son got together all he had, set off for a distant country and there <u>squandered his wealth in</u> <u>wild living</u>. ¹⁴After he had spent everything, there was a severe famine in that whole country, and <u>he began to be in need</u>.

Jeremiah 29:13, God said, "You will seek Me and find Me when you seek Me with all your heart."

2. I Must <u>OWN UP</u> To My <u>SIN</u>

Luke 15:17-18, When he came to his senses, he said, 'How many of my father's hired servants have food to spare, and here <u>I am starving to</u> <u>death</u>! ¹⁸I will set out and go back to my father and say to him: Father, <u>I have sinned against heaven and against you</u>.'

Isaiah 59:2, But <u>your iniquities</u> have separated you from your God; <u>your sins</u> have hidden His face from you, so that He will not hear.

<u>**Truth</u>**: You Are As <u>**CLOSE</u>** To God As You <u>**CHOOSE**</u> To Be.</u></u>

Psalm 51:1-4, Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your unfailing love; according to Your great compassion blot out my transgressions. ²Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin. ³For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. ⁴Against You, You only, have I sinned and done what is evil in Your sight; so You are right in Your verdict and justified when You judge.

Isaiah 1:18, "Come now, let us settle the matter," says the LORD. "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool."

<u>**2** Corinthians 13:5</u>, *Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you—unless, of course, you fail the test?*

3. I Must OFFER Up MYSELF

Luke 15:12, The younger one said to his father, 'Father, give me my share...'

Luke 15:19, I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me like one of your hired servants.'

<u>2 Corinthians 3:18</u>, And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord's glory, are being <u>transformed</u> into His image with <u>ever-increasing glory</u>, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.

Thought: Transformation Is A **PROCESS** But There Is A Starting **POINT**

Romans 12:1-2, Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in <u>view</u> of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. ²Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but <u>be transformed by the</u> <u>renewing of your mind</u>. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—His good, pleasing and perfect will.

Important Key-Note the Father's Response:

Luke 15:20-24, So he got up and went to his father. "But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, threw his arms around him and kissed him. ²¹ "The son said to him, 'Father, <u>I have sinned</u> against heaven and against you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son.'²² "But the father said to his servants, 'Quick! Bring the best robe and put it on him. Put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. ²³Bring the fattened calf and kill it. Let's have a feast and celebrate. ²⁴For this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.'So they began to celebrate.

4. I Must <u>LIFT</u> Up My <u>PRAISE</u>

Luke 15:23-24, Bring the fattened calf and kill it. Let's have a feast and celebrate. ²⁴For this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' So they began to celebrate.

<u>Psalm 68:4</u>, Sing to God, <u>sing in praise of His name</u>, extol Him who rides on the clouds; <u>rejoice before Him</u>—His name is the LORD.

Psalm 13:6, I will sing the LORD's praise, for He has been good to me.
