### **Three Basic Fears That Ruin Our Relationships:**

### 1) My Fear Of Exposure Makes Me DISTANT

**Genesis 3:9,** But the LORD God called to the man, "Where are you?" <sup>10</sup>He answered, "I heard You in the garden, and <u>I was afraid because I</u> was naked; so I hid." (NIV)

### Three Stages Of Relationship Damage:

<u>Genesis 3:7</u>, Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they <u>realized</u> <u>they were naked</u>; so they sewed fig leaves together and <u>made coverings</u> <u>for themselves</u>. <sup>8</sup>Then the man and his wife heard the sound of the LORD God as He was walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and <u>they hid</u> <u>from the LORD God among the trees of the garden</u>.

- They FELT SHAME (7a)
- They COVERED UP THEIR SIN (7b)
- They HID FROM GOD (8)

## 2) My Fear Of Disapproval Makes Me <u>DEFENSIVE</u>

<u>Genesis 3:12-13</u>, The man said, "<u>The woman You put here with me</u>—she gave me some fruit from the tree, and I ate it. Then the LORD God said to the woman, "What is this you have done?" The woman said, "<u>The serpent</u> <u>deceived me, and I ate</u>."

### 3) My Fear Of Losing Control Makes Me DEMANDING

**Genesis 3:16-19,** To the woman He said, "I will make your pains in childbearing very severe; with painful labor you will give birth to children. Your desire will be for your husband, and he will rule over you." <sup>17</sup>To Adam He said, "Because you listened to your wife and ate fruit from the tree about which I commanded you, 'You must not eat from it,' "Cursed is the ground because of you; through painful toil you will eat food from it all the days of your life. <sup>18</sup>It will produce thorns and thistles for you, and you will eat the plants of the field. <sup>19</sup>By the sweat of your brow you will eat your food until you return to the ground, since from it you were taken; for dust you are and to dust you will return."

# What Is The Antidote To Fear? LOVE!!!

**<u>1 John 4:18</u>**, There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love.

## **Three Daily Steps To Living In God's Love:**

## Step 1: I Will Surrender <u>MY HEART TO GOD</u>

**Job 11:13-18**, "Yet if you devote your heart to Him and stretch out your hands to Him, <sup>14</sup>if you put away the sin that is in your hand and allow no evil to dwell in your tent, <sup>15</sup>then, <u>free of fault, you will lift up your face; you will stand firm</u> and without fear. <sup>16</sup>You will surely forget your trouble, recalling it only as waters gone by. <sup>17</sup>Life will be brighter than noonday, and darkness will become like morning. <sup>18</sup>You will be secure, because there is hope; you will look about you and take your rest in safety.

## Step 2: I Must Remember God's LOVE FOR ME

• I'm Completely <u>ACCEPTED</u>

**<u>Titus 3:7</u>**, ... having been justified by His grace, we <u>might become</u> <u>heirs</u> having the hope of eternal life.

#### • I'm Unconditionally <u>LOVED</u>

**Isaiah 54:10,** Though the mountains be shaken and the hills be removed, <u>yet My unfailing love for you will not be shaken</u> nor My covenant of peace be removed, " says the LORD, Who has compassion on you.

• I'm Totally <u>FORGIVEN</u>

**Romans 8:1**, *Therefore, there is now <u>no condemnation</u> for those who are in Christ Jesus,* 

• I'm Extremely <u>VALUABLE</u> <u>1 Corinthians 7:23</u>, You were bought at a price....

## Step 3: I Must Offer That Same LOVE TO OTHERS

John 13:34, "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another.

**<u>Romans 15:7, Accept one another</u>**, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God.

<u>**1** Corinthians 13:7</u>, *It always protects, always <u>trusts, always hopes, always perseveres</u>. <sup>8</sup><i>Love never fails.*
