Palm Sunday Sermon Series: Impressions, Pt. 6 March 29, 2015

Luke 23:34, And Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do." And they cast lots to divide His garments.

Luke 23:26, And as they led Him away, they seized one Simon of *Cyrene, who was coming in from the country, and laid on him the* cross, to carry it behind Jesus. <sup>27</sup>And there followed Him a great multitude of the people and of women who were mourning and lamenting for Him. <sup>28</sup>But turning to them Jesus said, "Daughters of Jerusalem, do not weep for Me, but weep for yourselves and for your children. <sup>29</sup>For behold, the days are coming when they will say, 'Blessed are the barren and the wombs that never bore and the breasts that never nursed!'<sup>30</sup>Then they will begin to say to the mountains, 'Fall on us,' and to the hills, 'Cover us.' <sup>31</sup>For if they do these things when the wood is green, what will happen when it is dry?" <sup>32</sup>Two others, who were criminals, were led away to be put to death with Him. <sup>33</sup>And when they came to the place that is called The Skull, there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one on His right and one on His left. <sup>34</sup>And Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do." And they cast lots to divide His garments. <sup>35</sup>And the people stood by, watching, but the rulers scoffed at Him, saying, "He saved others; let Him save Himself, if He is the Christ of God, His *Chosen One!*" <sup>36</sup>*The soldiers also mocked Him, coming up and* offering Him sour wine <sup>37</sup> and saying, "If you are the King of the Jews, save Yourself!" <sup>38</sup>There was also an inscription over Him, "This is the King of the Jews." <sup>39</sup>One of the criminals who were hanged railed at Him, saving, "Are you not the Christ? Save yourself and us!" <sup>40</sup>But the other rebuked him, saving, "Do vou

not fear God, since you are under the same sentence of condemnation? <sup>41</sup>And we indeed justly, for we are receiving the due reward of our deeds; but this Man has done nothing wrong." <sup>42</sup>And he said, "Jesus, remember me when You come into Your kingdom." <sup>43</sup>And He said to him, "Truly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise."

#### What The Bible Says We Normally Do With Our Guilt:

#### • We Try To <u>BURY IT</u>

**Proverbs 28:13,** Whoever <u>conceals his transgressions will</u> <u>not prosper</u>, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy.

#### • We <u>BLAME OTHERS</u>

Genesis 3:12, The man said, "<u>The woman whom you gave to</u> <u>be with me</u>, she gave me fruit of the tree, and I ate." **Proverbs 19:3**, When a man's folly brings his way to ruin, <u>his</u> <u>heart rages against the Lord</u>.

### • We <u>BEAT OURSELVES UP</u>

**<u>Psalms 38:4</u>**, For my iniquities have gone over my head; <u>like</u> <u>A heavy burden, they are too heavy for me</u>...

### What Does Jesus Want Us To Do With Our Guilt?

 Just Admit It And <u>ACCEPT RESPONSIBILITY</u> <u>Proverbs 20:27</u>, The <u>spirit of man</u> is the lamp of the Lord, <u>searching all his innermost parts</u>. <u>Lamentations 3:40</u>, Let us test and examine our ways, and

**Lamentations 3:40**, Let us <u>test</u> and <u>examine our ways</u>, and return to the Lord!

### Just <u>OWN UP TO IT</u>

.

**<u>Psalms 51:3</u>**, For I know <u>my transgressions</u>, and <u>my sin</u> is ever before me.

James 5:16, Therefore, <u>confess your sins to one another and</u> <u>pray for one another</u>, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.

### Just <u>ASK FOR FORGIVENESS</u>

**<u>1</u>** John 1:9, If we <u>confess our sins</u>, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to <u>cleanse us from all</u> <u>unrighteousness</u>.

**Romans 3:23**, for <u>all have sinned</u> and fall short of the glory of God.

## What Will Jesus Do With My Guilt?

# He Forgives <u>INSTANTLY</u>

**Isaiah 55:7**, let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts; let him return to the Lord, that <u>He may have compassion</u> on him... for <u>He will abundantly pardon</u>.

# **He Forgives** <u>COMPLETELY</u>

<u>Colossians 2:13</u>, And you, who were dead in your trespasses...God made alive together with Him, <u>having</u> forgiven us all our trespasses, <sup>14</sup>by <u>canceling the record</u> of debt that stood against us <u>with its legal demands</u>. This He set aside, nailing it to the cross.

• He Forgives <u>REPEATEDLY</u>

Hebrews 7:25, Consequently, He is able to save to the uttermost those who draw near to God through Him, since He always <u>lives to make intercession for them</u>.

## • He Forgives <u>FREELY</u>

**Romans 8:1,** There is therefore <u>now no condemnation</u> for those who are in Christ Jesus. <sup>2</sup>For the law of the Spirit of life has <u>set you free</u> in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death. **Psalms 32:1,** Blessed is the one whose <u>transgression is</u> forgiven, whose <u>sin is covered</u>. <sup>2</sup>Blessed is the man against whom the Lord <u>counts no iniquity</u>, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.
