# The Anatomy Of Temptation And How We Deal With It! Legit Faith: All Day, Everyday! Pt. 2

James 1:13-18 April 10, 2016

James 1:13, When tempted, no one should say, "God is tempting me." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He tempt anyone; <sup>14</sup>but each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed. <sup>15</sup>Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death. <sup>16</sup>Don't be deceived, my dear brothers and sisters. <sup>17</sup>Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows. <sup>18</sup>He chose to give us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of firstfruits of all He created.

# **Temptation:** To Lure, Attract, Seduce Or Entice

• Two Common <u>RESPONSES</u> To Temptation:

<u>James 1:13</u>, When tempted, no one should say, "<u>God is tempting me</u>." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He tempt anyone...

#### 1) We Blame OTHERS

Genesis 3:9, ... God called to the man, "Where are you?" ... <sup>12</sup>The man said, "The woman You put here with me—she gave me some fruit from the tree, and I ate it." <sup>13</sup>Then the Lord God said to the woman, "What is this you have done?" The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."

## 2) We Blame GOD

<u>Proverbs 19:3</u>, A man's <u>own folly</u> ruins his life, yet his heart rages against the LORD."

• The **STRUCTURE** And Source Of Temptation:

<u>James 1:14</u>, ... but each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed. <sup>15</sup>Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death.

## 1) Temptation Is Common To ALL OF US

<u>1 Corinthians 10:13</u>, No temptation has overtaken you except what is <u>common to mankind</u>. And God is faithful; He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, He will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.

## 3) Temptation Comes From SATAN

Matthew 4:1, Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. <sup>2</sup> After fasting forty days and forty nights, He was hungry. <sup>3</sup> The tempter came to Him and said, "If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread." <sup>4</sup> Jesus answered, "It is written: 'Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.'" (Hebrews 4:15)

### Example: Two Very Different <u>PATHS</u>

1) Genesis 39:11, One day he went into the house to attend to his duties, and none of the household servants was inside. <sup>12</sup>She caught him by his cloak and said, "Come to

bed with me!" But he left his cloak in her hand and <u>ran</u> <u>out of the house</u>.

- 2) <u>2 Samuel 11:2</u>, One evening David got up from his bed and walked around on the roof of the palace. From the roof he <u>saw</u> a woman bathing. The woman was very beautiful, <sup>3</sup> and David <u>sent</u> someone to find out about her. The man said, "She is Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam and the wife of Uriah the Hittite." <sup>4</sup>Then David sent messengers <u>to get her</u>. She came to him, and <u>he</u> slept with her.
- The Cure For Our Failure: Own It, Confess It And PREVENT IT!

<u>1 John 1:9</u>, *If we <u>confess our sins</u>*, *He is faithful and just and will <u>forgive us our sins</u> and purify us from all unrighteousness.

(1 John 2:1-2)* 

Psalm 11:9, How can a young person stay on the path of purity? By living according to Your word. <sup>10</sup>I seek You with all my heart; do not let me stray from Your commands. <sup>11</sup>I have hidden Your word in my heart that I might not sin against You. (Hebrews 10:23-25)

Psalm 51:1, Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your unfailing love; according to Your great compassion blot out my transgressions. <sup>2</sup>Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin. <sup>3</sup>For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. <sup>4</sup>Against You, You only, have I sinned and done what is evil in Your sight; so You are right in Your verdict and justified when You judge... <sup>7</sup>Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be

whiter than snow. <sup>8</sup>Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones You have crushed rejoice. <sup>9</sup>Hide Your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquity. <sup>10</sup>Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.
