### 1) A Man Looking For JESUS

• His Prominence, Position And POWER

Mark 8:36, What good is it for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? <sup>37</sup>Or what can anyone give in exchange for their soul?

# • His Preoccupation And Desperate <u>NEED</u> <u>Acts 4:12</u>, "Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved."

• His Problem - The Crowd And His <u>CONDITION</u>
<u>Jeremiah 29:13</u>, You will seek Me and find Me when you seek Me with all your heart.

### 2) Jesus Looking For A MAN

<u>Luke 19:5</u>, When Jesus reached the spot, He looked up and said to him, "<u>Zacchaeus</u>, <u>come down immediately</u>. <u>I must stay at your house today</u>."

 Jesus Knew Everything About Him And <u>CALLED</u> <u>HIM</u>

Matthew 20:28, just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.

### 3) A Man Who Finds SALVATION

Luke 19:6, So he came down at once and welcomed Him gladly. <sup>7</sup>All the people saw this and began to mutter, "He has gone to be the guest of a sinner." <sup>8</sup>But Zacchaeus stood up and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord! Here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount." <sup>9</sup>Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham. <sup>10</sup>For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."

• He Welcomed Jesus Openly And GLADLY
Revelation 3:20, Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with Me.

<u>1 John 1:9</u>, If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
