KEY PASSAGE: Proverbs 2:6-7

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- Where does wisdom come from? Wisdom comes from God through His Word.

BIBLE STORY:

WISDOM FOR GOD'S PEOPLE

- Solomon asked God for wisdom.
- Solomon wrote down the wise things God revealed to him.
- The Book of Proverbs teaches wise ways to live.
- Wisdom is fearing the Lord and obeying His word.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- What is the difference between knowledge and wisdom?
- What do you think it means to fear the Lord?
- Can you usually trust what a wise person says?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Spend some time journaling with your kids. Encourage them to write down the things God reveals to them in His Word. Discuss differences between what God says is wise, and what the world says is wise.
